The information we collect

We use software tools such as Goggle Analytics (which is compliant with the new GDPR legislation) to measure and collect session information, including page response times, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information, and methods used to browse away from the page. We also collect personally identifiable information (including name, email, communications) comments and feedback via our Contact Us and Subscribe forms.

We will use your personal information to answer queries, send out email newsletters and notice of our services, take appropriate payments and communicate with you about bookings.

How we store, use, share and disclose your personal information

Peace of Mind Now is hosted on the Wix.com platform. Wix.com provides us with the online platform that allows us to provide and market our services to you. Your data may be stored through Wix.com's data storage, databases and the general Wix.com applications. They store your data on secure servers behind a firewall.

Any information received via our contact us page on the website is stored via Wix logging system and deleted after 31 days unless further communication has been made.
